### **REMINDER TO LOG IN YOUR PPHOURS**

Please remember to log your PPH hours! Hours must be completed by May 31 and logged no later than June 7, 2017 to receive credit for the 2016 / 2017 school year.

### **Greetings from the Parish Education Committee,**

The end of March break signals the home stretch to the end of the 2016 / 2017 school year. As we all begin to look forward to longer (and hopefully sunnier days), it's easy to forget that the fiscal year end for PPH hours is May 31, 2017.

This is your friendly reminder that you need to have all your PPH hours for this school year completed by May 31 and logged on the PPH website within 1 week of that date. The official cut-off date for hours to be logged will be June 7, 2017. If you have hours logged that are not yet approved, please contact the approving coordinator to ensure they complete this important process to give you credit for your hours.

Any hours performed **after** May 31 will count towards the 2017 / 2018 school year, but it is important to ensure you have all 40 hours for this year completed prior to this date (including the mandatory parking lot / playground supervision hours as outlined in the registration package).

If you do not have the required number of hours completed by June 1, your PPH deposit cheque(s) will be cashed and your completed hours will be reimbursed with payment from the school on the basis of \$20 per hour.
